Institute of Post Graduate Teaching & Research in Ayurveda

In 1954, Govt. of India had established a central Institute of Research in Ayurveda at Jamnagar. On 20th July, 1956 a Post Graduate Training Centre in Ayurveda (PGTCA) was established in Jamnagar. Initially, there were four post Graduate Departments namely Basic Principles; Kayachikitsa, Dravyaguna and Rasa Shastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana, in which a two-year postgraduate course viz. "Higher Proficiency in Ayurveda (H.P.A.)" was conducted at this Institute.

This set continued up to 1963. After that, the three Institutes of Jamnagar viz. The Central institute for Research in Indigenous Systems of Medicine (CIRISM), the Post Graduate Training Center in Ayurveda (PGTCA) and The Gulabkunwarba Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya were amalgamated and given a new name - Institute for Ayurvedic Studies and Research (IASR).

On 5th January 1967, the Gujarat Ayurveda University, Jamnagar was established by taking over the IASR. The Post Graduate Center became integral part of the University and was renamed as Institute of Post Graduate Teaching and Research (I.P.G.T. & R.). At this juncture, a new fifth Post Graduate department was started i.e. Deptt. of Shalya Shalakyas. The same course of H.P.A. was adopted by the University for a two year Post Graduate Degree named as Master of Shuddha Ayurvedic Medicine (M.S.A.M.). In 1973, the duration of the degree M.S.A.M. was enhanced to three years duration. In 1975, the M.S.A.M. degree was replaced by M.D. (Ayu).

Initially, the department of Shalya Shalakyas was also carrying out the research and teaching in the field of Striroga, Prasutitantra and Kaumarbhritya. Later on in 1979, sixth P.G. department was established as Deptt of Kaumarbhritya. In the year 2003 the Board of Post Graduate Teaching & Research has been formed and in the year 2004 two new Departments came into the existence viz. Shalakyas Trantra and Stri Roga & Prasuti Tantra. In 2005 8th new Department has been established as Department of Panchakarma. These departments impart P.G. Teaching and conduct Researches in twelve Specialities viz. Maulika Siddhanta, Samhita, Kayachikitsa, Roga Nidana Vikriti Vijnan, Panchakarma, Prasuti Tantra & Stri Roga, Kaumarabhritya, Shalya, Shalakyas, Rasa Shastra, Bhaishajya Kalpana and Dravya Guna.

In 1977, the provision for the award of Ph.D. degree was also made by the University in I.P.G.T. & R.

This institute also runs short term Foreigners Training Programme in Ayurveda of three months duration. This Institute is also a W.H.O. Training center for Ayurveda. Recently this university has been recognized as “**Centre of Excellence**” under Gujarat Ayurved University by Govt. of Gujarat.

6. The candidate must have completed minimum 12 month internship of 4 ½ years B.A.M.S. course and 6 month minimum internship / house job of 5 years B.A.M.S. course, after passing the final Professional Examination on or before by 31.07.2007.

Teachers / Medical Officers etc. nominated by Govt. of India and Govt. of Gujarat for Ahmedabad center as well as foreign applicants are exempted from Admission Entrance Test. All the nominated candidates shall be allotted the recommended subjects / specialities. For the nomination on the seats of Govt. of India nominee candidates have to apply directly to the Govt. of India through their respective state Governments.

General Instruction for filling up the application form:

- The common application form, for both Jamnagar and Ahmedabad Centers, can be obtained from the website of the University (www.ayurveduniversity.com)which can be DOWNLOADED and duly filled in the candidate's own handwriting and should be sent to the Director – I.P.G.T. & R.A., Gujarat Ayurved University, Jamnagar along with a Demand Draft / Pay Order / bankers cheque of Rs. 1000/- of a nationalize bank payable at Jamnagar and necessary documents. All the columns of the application form should be completed by furnishing all the information asked for. Incompletely filled application forms and those, which are attached without duly self attested copies of Marksheets of all the examinations passed and other required certificates are liable for rejection.
- The common application form, for both Jamnagar and Ahmedabad Centers, can also be obtained from *the Director, I.P.G.T. & R.A., Gujarat Ayurved University, Jamnagar*, by sending **one self addressed envelop of 11" X 5" size duly affixed with postal stamp worth Rupees Thirty Five (Rs.35/=) on each.**
- All the candidates seeking nomination on government seats should submit their applications form through proper channel to the Department of AYUSH, Govt. of India, New Delhi (nominee of Govt. of India) and Department of I. S. M & H., Govt. of Gujarat, Gandhinagar (nominee of Govt. of Gujarat). Nomination may be done by respective Governments to the I.P.G.T. & R.A., Gujarat Ayurved University, Jamnagar with clear indications from the concerned department regarding the terms and conditions, allotment of specialities of the nominated candidate for the training course.
- Attested copies of the following documents must accompany with the application:
 - Marks Sheet of H.S.C. (10+2) or intermediate or equivalent.
 - All the Mark Sheets of First to Final year B.A.M.S. Examination / First to Final professional B.A.M.S. Examination.
 - Internship completed or internship likely to be completed on or before 31st July 2007, certificate from the competent authority for the same should also be attached.
 - For the proof of age, attested copy of the certificate of High School or S.S.C. or equivalent examination must be attached.
 - Domicile certificate from a 1st class Magistrate or Tehasildar of the place.
 - S.C. / S.T. / O.B.C. certificate from the District Magistrate, the District Tribal Welfare Officer or the appropriate authorities for the reserved categories. **Reservation under OBC quota is subject to the provisions made by Government of India and clearance in light of Supreme Court directives. Candidates applying under OBC Quota have to submit non-creamy layer certificate.**
 - Conduct certificate from the head of the Institution (last attended) or from the Head of the Office, if the candidate is in service, must be attached.
 - Photograph on the application form must be coloured, passport size, recent and one identical extra photograph sent along with application form for admit card.
 - One self addressed envelop of 11" X 5" size duly affixed with postal stamp worth Rupees Thirty Five (Rs.35/=) on each
- The candidate should have the knowledge of Hindi, Sanskrit and English.
- The candidates will have to come and *stay for the Entrance Test* when they are called for, *at their own expenses.*
- The candidates are informed that forms received through Registered post or Courier shall only be entertained for the Admission purpose.
- Fixation of latest passport size photograph of the candidate on the place mentioned on the form is compulsory failing which application will not be considered.
- All the candidates are hereby instructed to mention their Telephone, Fax & E-mail address compulsorily for prompt communication and to avoid unnecessary frustration.
- The selected candidate shall have to submit a Bond on non-judicial stamp as per the proforma given. In case of leaving the course in between the candidate shall have to deposit Rs. 50,000/- (rupees fifty thousand only) along with scholarship, which he / she received during course, if any.
- No M.D. (Ayu) / M.S. (Ayu) student shall accept any paid or unpaid assignment of Government or private firm or Body or self-employment during the period of his / her studies.

Selection:

12. The selection will be strictly on merit as determined on the basis of the performance in the qualifying examination of 80 marks in the written test comprising of objective type of questions of B.A.M.S. standard and the marks obtained in the subject concerned in BAMS and total marks.
13. The candidates are advised to see column 7(e) to know the specialities available at I.P.G.T. & R.A., Jamnagar and Post Graduate Center, Ahmedabad. Allotment of specialities to the candidates shall be done strictly on merit of Entrance Examination and availability of seats. They should mention their order of preference for Jamnagar center and Ahmedabad center.
14. Eligible candidates admitted to the course on stipendiary seats will be entitled to get monthly stipend as determined by the Govt. of India for I.P.G.T.& R.A and as determined by the Govt. of Gujarat for P.G. Upgraded Centre Akhandanand Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Ahmedabad; from time to time, subject to his/her maintaining satisfactory attendance, progress and conduct.
15. The candidate will be supplied one questionnaire containing 80 questions
16. The answers are to be written by ball pen only in the provided space, the use of pencil, ink pen and eraser is strictly prohibited
17. Third and last copy of the triplicate answer sheet will be given to candidate by invigilators after getting sign of the candidate
